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	<p>All the members of the Governing Council were welcomed to the first meeting for the academic year 2014-2015 and took the privilege of thanking each of the members for their continued support with suggestions, healthy criticisms and for striving towards the upliftment of the institutions in all respects.</p>	
	<p>As per the agenda for the meeting, the admissions status for the academic year 2014-15, was taken up and the principal presented the admission data. Members pointed to the fact that in spite of all the efforts, good encouraging results, required in-fact 2000 and various other added advantages, the admissions are not fulfilled for the absolute strength and expressed their concern. It was also pointed that until complete admissions are done as per the sanctioned intake on continual academic year, the institution should not go for taking additional seats.</p>	
	<p>Further, it was deliberated that few more academic oriented quality initiatives need to be developed and practiced to install more confidence among the learners community to take admissions in the institution and prefer our institution than others.</p>	
	<p>It was rightly observed by Dr. N. Sandaravijan, Vice-Chancellor Jain University and member Governing Council, who said that BBA admission have improved as folds than last time and suggested to the principal to find the reasons for not able to fill the seats in B Com and BCA, while it was possible to complete the sanctioned intake during the last academic year.</p>	
	<p>Adding to the discussion, Mr. Mahendar Monoth, Managing Trustee provided one more additional information that since the nearby Government first Grade College, had additional sanctioned intake for B Com and BCA this time, the parents had a choice for their wards to opt them and hence some seats have fallen vacant and added that the situation would not remain the same in future.</p>	
	<p>All the members insisted that some more academic oriented improvising measures be taken by the principal and initiate</p>	

the process with the concerned department and members of the faculty so that seats are filled in courses like B. Com and BCA.

for this point, Principal appraised the honourable members of the Governing Council that as suggested during the last academic year Governing Council Meeting, many academic oriented initiatives were taken by the institution in consultation with ARG, Heads of the Departments and in tune to the requirement of the CBCS course curriculum across all the streams and semesters.

Principal, appraised the members of the several value additions programmes that were initiated and implemented during the present semester of the academic year and details report of the programme delivered through various resources personnel drawn from the industry subject experts, qualified trainers and other guest faculty members.

Further, Principal pointed that the recruitment for BCA is not happening as it used to be and hence there is a downfall in admissions, while the same situation does not apply to B. Com course and hence he agreed that things would improve in the due course of time with some initiated effort from the concerned department and the institution at large.

At this point, Sri Sankar Chaudji reminded the members of the Governing Council as to what happened to the decision to give up BA and CBM course from continuing their affiliation. And it was said that last LIC Chairman has suggested not to ask for discontinuation of these courses but give one more attempt to revive with admissions.

However, with all the effort put for reviving these courses with minimum admissions, no further progress is

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	<p>achieved. Hence, a serious thought has to be given and request the University to disaffiliate these two courses from the next academic year and onwards.</p>	
	<p>Moving to the next agenda, Principal informed the members of the governing council that the NAAC accreditation with B grade has completed one year on 25<sup>th</sup> October 2014 and hence the institution has to submit the AQAR report shortly.</p>	
	<p>Mrs. Nozreen Ahmed, Steering Committee, Co-ordinator NAAC and IQAC presented the following points that is to be incorporated in the AQAR report.</p>

	<p>OPAQ was installed and server client connected</p>	

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
