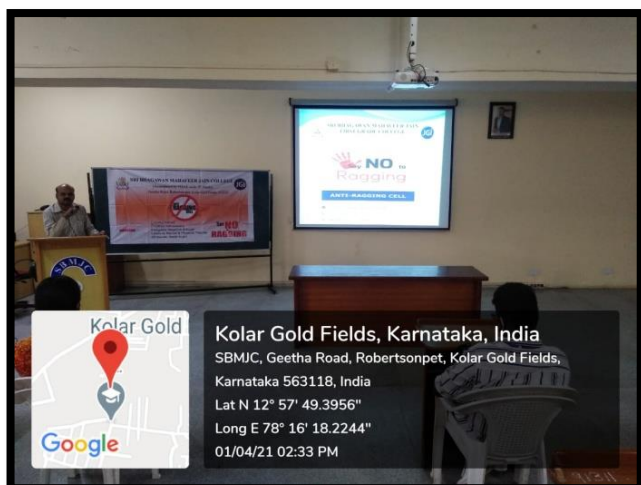


7.1.9 Sensitization of students and Employees of the Institution to the Constitutional Obligation: Values, Rights, Duties and Responsibilities of Citizens
